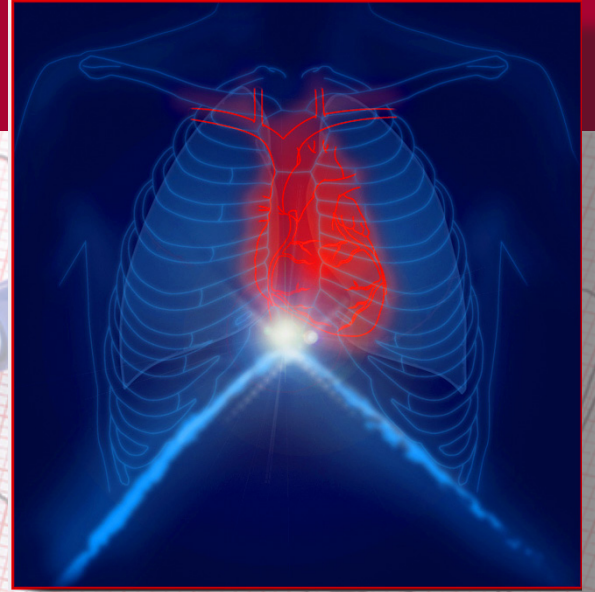

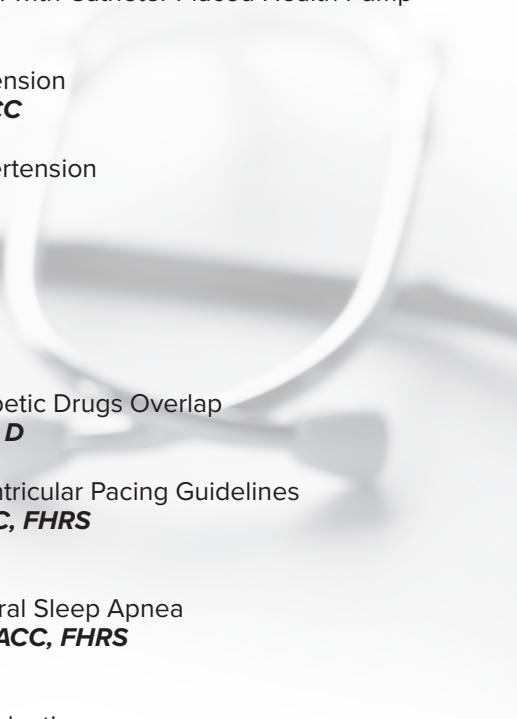
Target Audience: Cardiovascular Surgeons, Physicians, Nurses and Allied Health Professionals
